PERSONALITY DEVELOPMENT:



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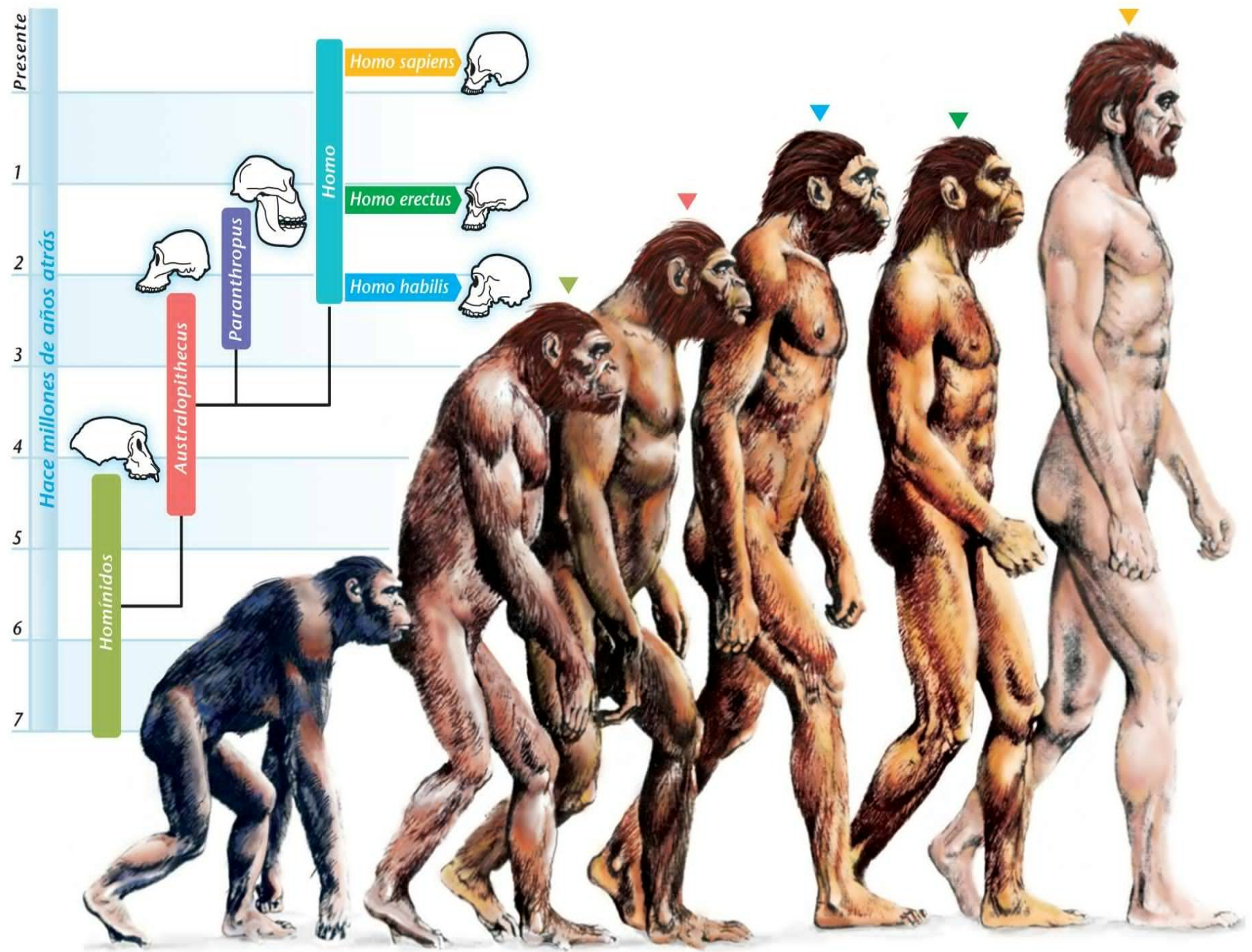
Personality traits are defined as the relatively enduring patterns of thoughts, feelings, and behaviors that distinguish individuals from one another.

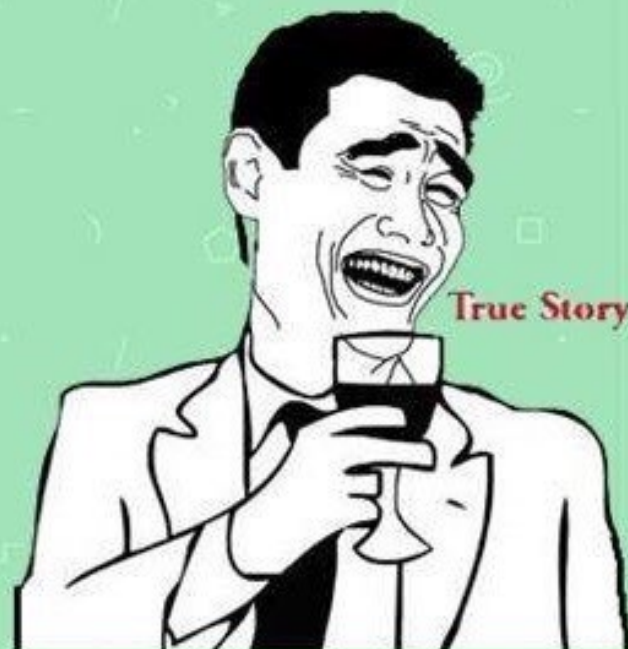

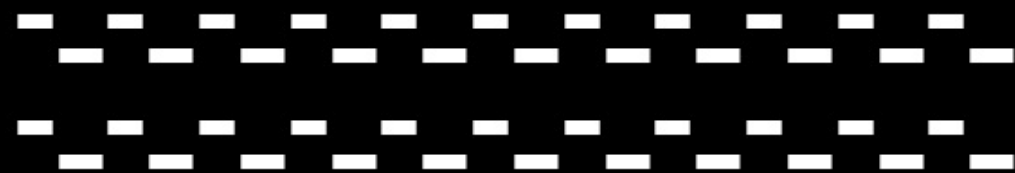

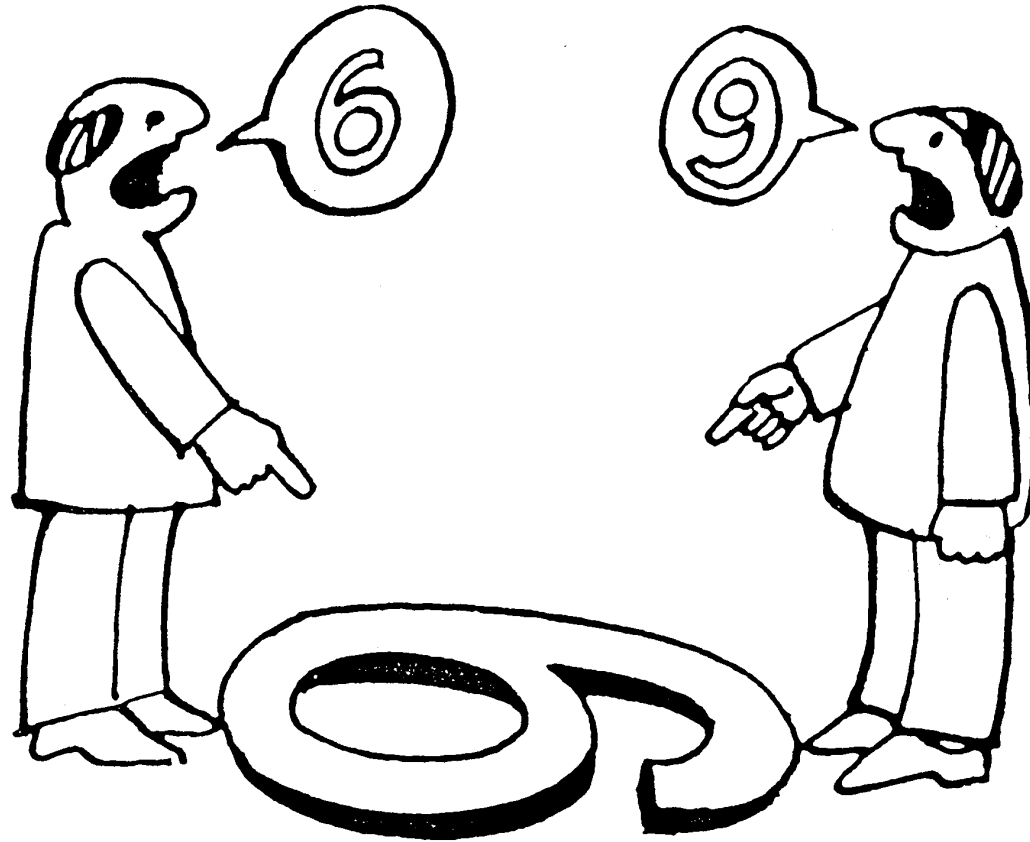

tax his dirt.




Tax his chew, tax
